


Am I at risk of prostate cancer?

In the UK, about 1 in 8 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime. We don't know exactly what causes prostate cancer but there are some things that may mean you are more likely to get it – these are called risk factors.

There are three main prostate cancer risk factors, which are things you can't change.

These are:

- getting older it mainly affects men aged 50 or over
- having a <u>family history of prostate cancer</u>
- being <u>Black</u>.

If you have any of these risk factors or if you have any <u>symptoms</u>, speak to your GP.

They can talk to you about your risk, and about the <u>tests</u> that are used to diagnose prostate cancer. You can also get in touch with <u>our Risk Information Service</u>, who can help you understand your risk of prostate cancer.







2024 World Darts Championship: Treble 20 stays red as PDC and Paddy Power support Prostate Cancer UK
